The RoHS directive states:

“A maximum concentration of 0.1% by weight in homogenous materials for lead, mercury, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) and polybrominated biphenyl ethers (PBDE) and of 0.01% by weight in homogenous materials for cadmium shall be tolerated.”

In addition all of our products are in compliance with the European Union Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) directives 2002/96/EC and 2012/19/EU.

The RoHS and WEEE directives provide guidelines to restrict the use and disposal of hazardous substances in the material composition of the components we supply throughout the supply chain.
